<p>1</p> 	<p>Attention: Make sure not to damage the o-ring, which is responsible for the tightness between the radiator and the fitting, when tightening it.</p>
<p>2.a (PEX 16x2)</p> 	<p>Attention You must know that during the assembly of the 16x2 fitting you do not damage the o-rings, which are responsible for the tightness of the fitting between the installation and the valve.</p>

Insert the nipple 9n into the valve body and tighten with a 25 wrench.</p>	<p>2.c (Cu 15x1)</p>  <p>Attention: Remove sharp material residues from the outside of the 15x1 tubing that could damage the rubber gasket of the coupling when pressing it over the tubing. After crimping the coupler with a force of 15Nm, first check that it is not possible to turn and / or extend the tube by pulling it STRONGLY, and then check the hydraulic tightness. Keep 90° angle between the pipe and the heater.</p>

Terms of warranty:

- The warranty does not cover parts that are subject to natural wear and tear during their lifetime, and defects caused as a result installation and use inconsistent with the instructions, defects bearing signs of mechanical or thermal damage or signs of user interference.
- The Purchaser loses all rights resulting from the guarantee in the event of: 1) loss or destruction of the proof of purchase, 2) unauthorized repairs, disassembly, 3) improper or inconsistent with the instructions for use.
